We had many highlights on this trip, as we did with the other Vietnam trips, but for this group the cruise on Ha Long Bay was a major highlight. A dinner highlight was the "White Night" dinner at the Deck House An Bang Beach Hoi An where we enjoyed a 7-course meal and the food was amazing.

The night Sharon wanted to try the Morning Glory Restaurant in Hoi An – 2 of us accompanied her. The other ladies decided to spend a night in at the resort. When it was time to leave the restaurant we heard torrential rain on the roof. Not a happy sight given we were not dressed for rain and we had a 10-minute walk to the resort. Luckily there were industrious Vietnamese women outside the restaurant selling plastic ponchos at inflated prices. We bought one each! Ponchos on we stepped out into the torrential rain and flooding streets. We arrived back at the hotel looking like 3 drowned rats and 3 of our travellers were sitting having cocktails – when they saw us they rolled up laughing! How rude of them \textcircled . We were dripping water all over the floor but the staff were laughing as well and they didn't care about the puddles.

In Hanoi we enjoyed dinner at a lovely little family restaurant and later had a walk through the pedestrian street (closed to cars and motorbikes on Fridays and Saturday nights). After visiting the Red Bridge and the beautiful lake we wandered back towards our hotel. As we started to cross a square a DJ was playing. Sharon decided to have a little dance as we walked, I joined her and the other ladies stopped to laugh at us when a circle of people started to form around us to watch these western ladies dancing. The funniest thing was the DJ stopped playing music because we had taken his crowd. Once we walked away and the crowd dispersed he turned the music back on and that was really amusing. Young people were videoing us so I wonder where that clip could end up. On Tic Toc called "western grannies dancing" or "2 crazy old ladies trying to dance". We enjoyed ourselves and weren't hurting anyone © It was a funny few minutes and I'm sure we'll laugh about it for many months. But that's what makes a trip fun and memorable...those things which (within reason and harmless) you probably wouldn't do at home.
